

Asylum policies and the distribution of applications

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We provide empirical evidence about the effect of various dimensions of asylum policies on the distribution of asylum applications across European countries. A longer time for processing the applications reduces, on average, the number of first-time applications, but it increases applications originating from countries whose citizens have low chances of being granted refugee status.
